Did you know our pets are good at hiding pain. Two out of five dogs over the age of one show signs of osteoarthritis and 90% cats over the age of twelve have joint changes on x-ray. So, chances are your pet's mobility is likely to be affected.

Our practice nurse Steph runs mobility clinics, where she can give advice and treatment to help pets lead a healthier, more comfortable life.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING YOUR APPOINTMENT:

You will be given a questionnaire to fill out before your appointment. Either by email or in person.

Initial **45-minute consult** to discuss your pets' clinical signs.

Pain and weight management discussions.

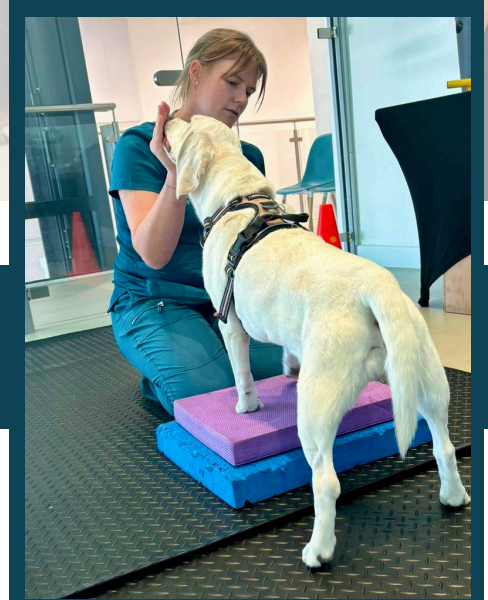
Clinical examination of your pet to ascertain which body area(s) are affected.

In consult treatments to include **laser therapy and physiotherapy.**

Physiotherapy exercise plan to follow at home

Information pack to go home with.

Follow up consultations are 30 minutes.
